

Deputy Governor Vathana Dalaloy of BOL received a farewell IMF's Resident Representative for Lao PDR and Vietnam




Deputy Governor Vathana Dalaloy of the Bank of Lao PDR received a farewell call from Mr. Sanjay Kalra, IMF's Resident Representative for Lao PDR and Vietnam in Vientiane on July 1st 2015.
